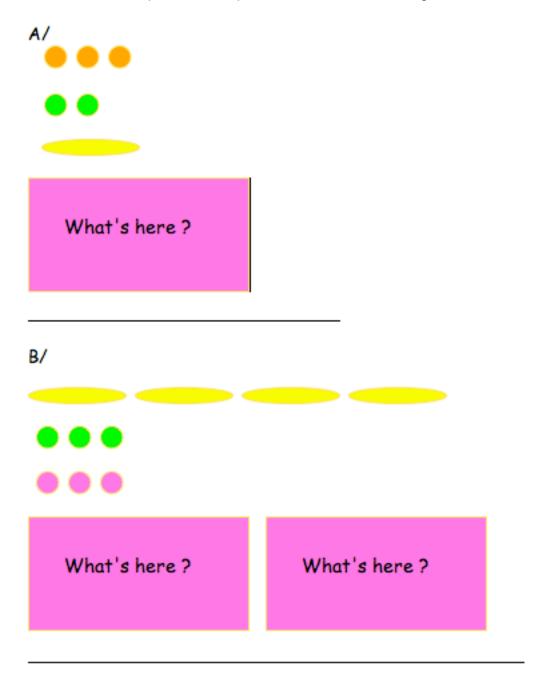
A bowl of fruit
