Imagine you were given the chance to win some money... and imagine you had nothing to lose...


Imagine you arrive in a room where you are given $£ 128$ and six cards ( 3 red winning cards and 3 black losing cards).

You are asked to choose and lay the cards down, one at a time. You can decide in which order to lay them down.

At each stage you must bet exactly half the money that you have available.
If you select and play a black card you lose the money you bet.
If you select and play a red card you receive double the money you bet (ie. you get the money you bet back, plus that amount again, so if you bet $£ 64$ and win, your total will increase by $£ 64$ ).

If you end up with more money than you started with you get to keep the profit.

## What's the best order for laying down the cards?

What will your strategy be when you are offered 4 or 5 red winning cards? Draw some conclusions on what strategy to adopt and try to justify your findings.
