Mrs Voce bought fish balls and a moon cake. The cost of both of them together is in one of the boxes below. Only coins were used to buy the items.

| $\$ 15.1$ | $\$ 20$ | $\$ 21$ | $\$ 9$ | $\$ 18.3$ |

| $\$ 5.5$ | $\$ 11.5$ | $\$ 10$ | $\$ 22.5$ | $\$ 12.4$ |
| $\$ 14.5$ | $\$ 17.9$ | $\$ 12.2$ | $\$ 19.2$ | $\$ 13.5$ |

Use the below clues to find out:
a) How much Mrs Voce paid.
b) The cost of the fish balls and moon cake individually.
c) The minimum number of coins used to pay.

## Clues

1. There would be change if only $\$ 10$ coins were used.
2. More than 3 coins are needed to make this amount.
3. The fish balls cost more than the moon cake but less than double the cost of the moon cake.
4. You can pay without using the same coin twice.
5. The moon cake costs $\$ 5.5$
