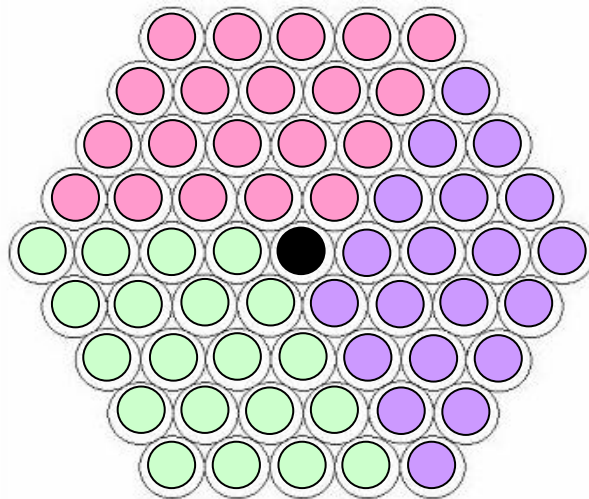


Penny ate 10 chocolates, which created a triangle. She timesed the 10 chocolates by 6 which made the triangles fit in the box with one left over in the middle, so there were 61 chocolates.

Tom ate 20 chocolates, which made a parallelogram. He timesed the 20 chocolates by 3 to make 60 and added the extra chocolate that was in the middle, and ended up with 61 chocolates.



Matthew ate 24 chocolates, which is 4×6 and in each inner ring it is 6 less than the outer ring before it and there are 4 rings, so if he added the amount of chocolates he would get 60 chocolates, plus the extra chocolate in the middle then he would get 61 chocolates.
