

Jen has 3 sweets  
Her brother gave her 5 more sweets.  
How many sweets did Jen have then?

$$3 + 5 = [ ]$$

Jeje had 10 toy cars  
He gave 4 of them to his friend Raj  
How many cars did Jeje have then?

$$10 - 4 = [ ]$$

Su had 5 stickers  
Her mother gave her some more.  
Then Su had 9 stickers.  
How many stickers did his mother give him?

$$5 + [ ] = 9$$

Lily had 7 balloons.  
Some of them popped.  
Then Lily had 3 balloons.  
How many balloons had popped?

$$7 - [ ] = 3$$

Some children were going for a walk.  
3 more children joined them.  
Then there were 9 children.  
How many children were walking at the start?

$$[ ] + 3 = 9$$

Sacha had some coins in his pocket.  
He lost 7 of them.  
Then he had 3 in his pocket.  
How many coins did he have at the start?

$$[ ] - 7 = 3$$

Jim had 5 red marbles.  
Mimi had 4 blue marbles.  
How many marbles did they have altogether?

$$5 + 4 = [ ]$$

The mother dog had 8 puppies.  
3 of them were brown and the rest were black.  
How many black puppies were there?

$$8 - 3 = [ ]$$

My friend found 9 coins.  
Her sister, Jo found 6 coins.  
How many more coins did my friend have than Jo?

$$9 - 6 = [ ]$$

Ann and Daeda were catching bugs  
Ann caught 10 and Daeda caught 7.  
How many more bugs does Daeda need to catch  
to have as many as Ann?

$$10 - 7 = [ ]$$
