

### **Everyday Maths Project: Summary of the Questionnaire Data**

In total, 243 questionnaires were completed by parents of Year 3 pupils, across 18 primary schools. Summaries of responses to each question follow. Not all parents answered all questions, so the total number of responses to each question differ.
