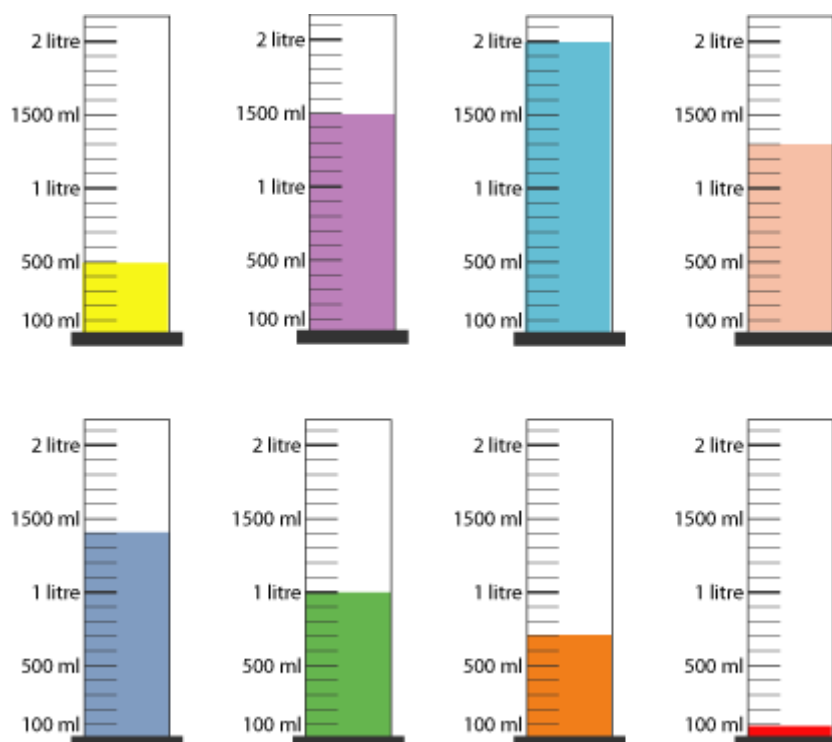




A group of eight children were measuring coloured water using measuring cylinders. The cylinders were labelled with a child's name and the amount they had measured out.
