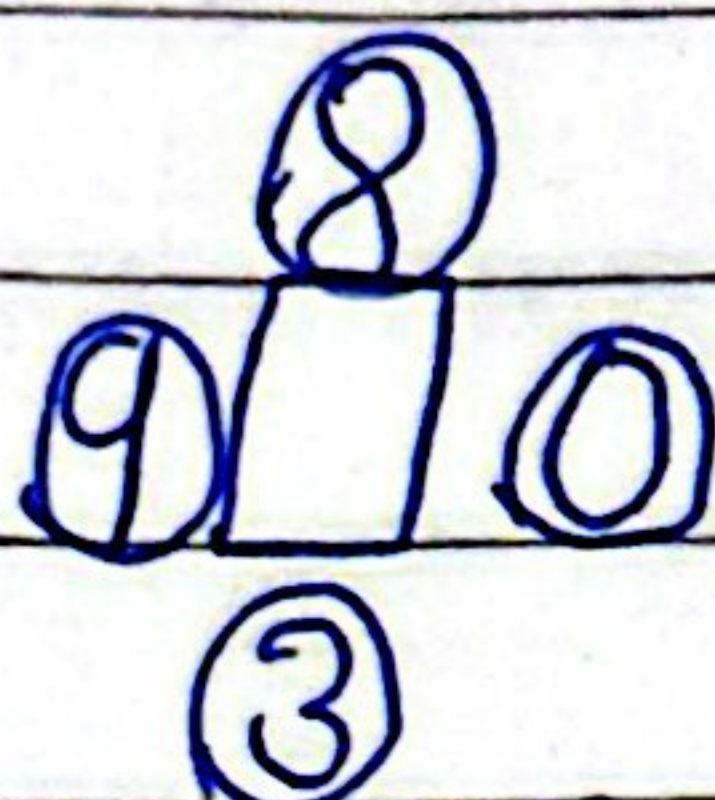

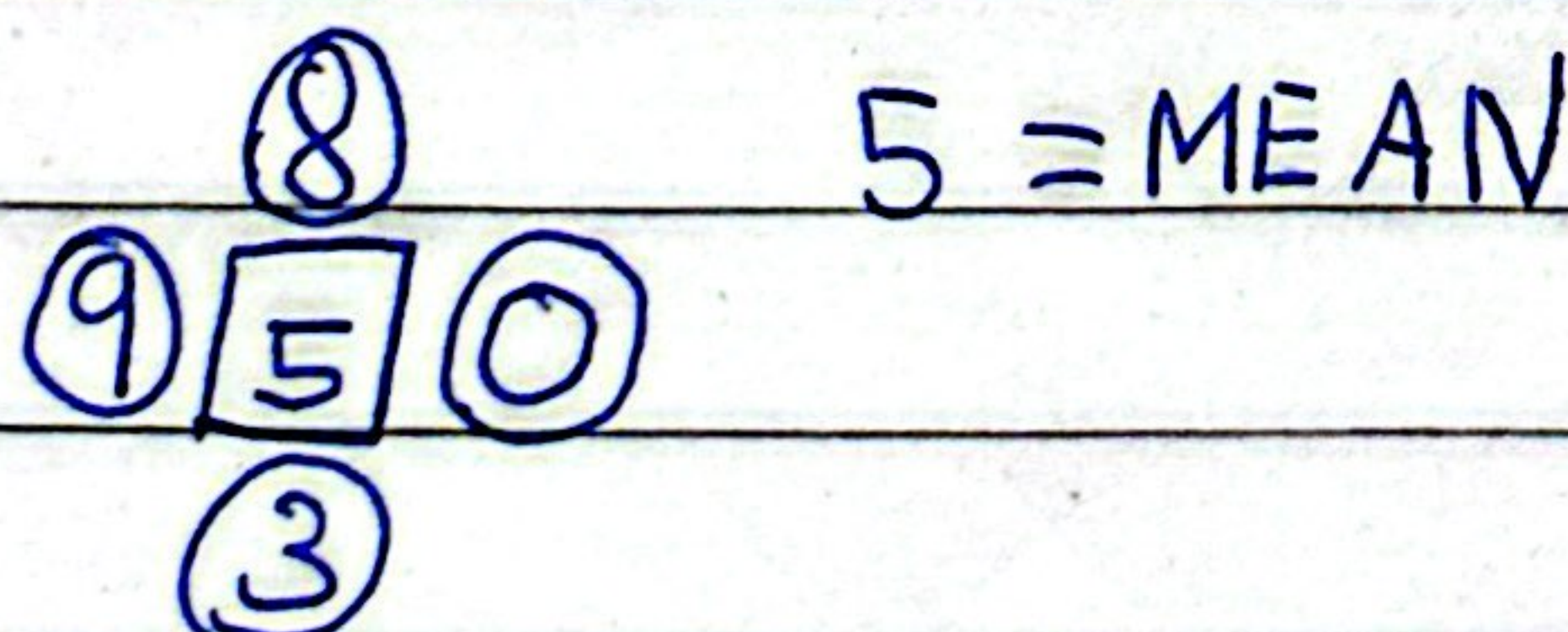

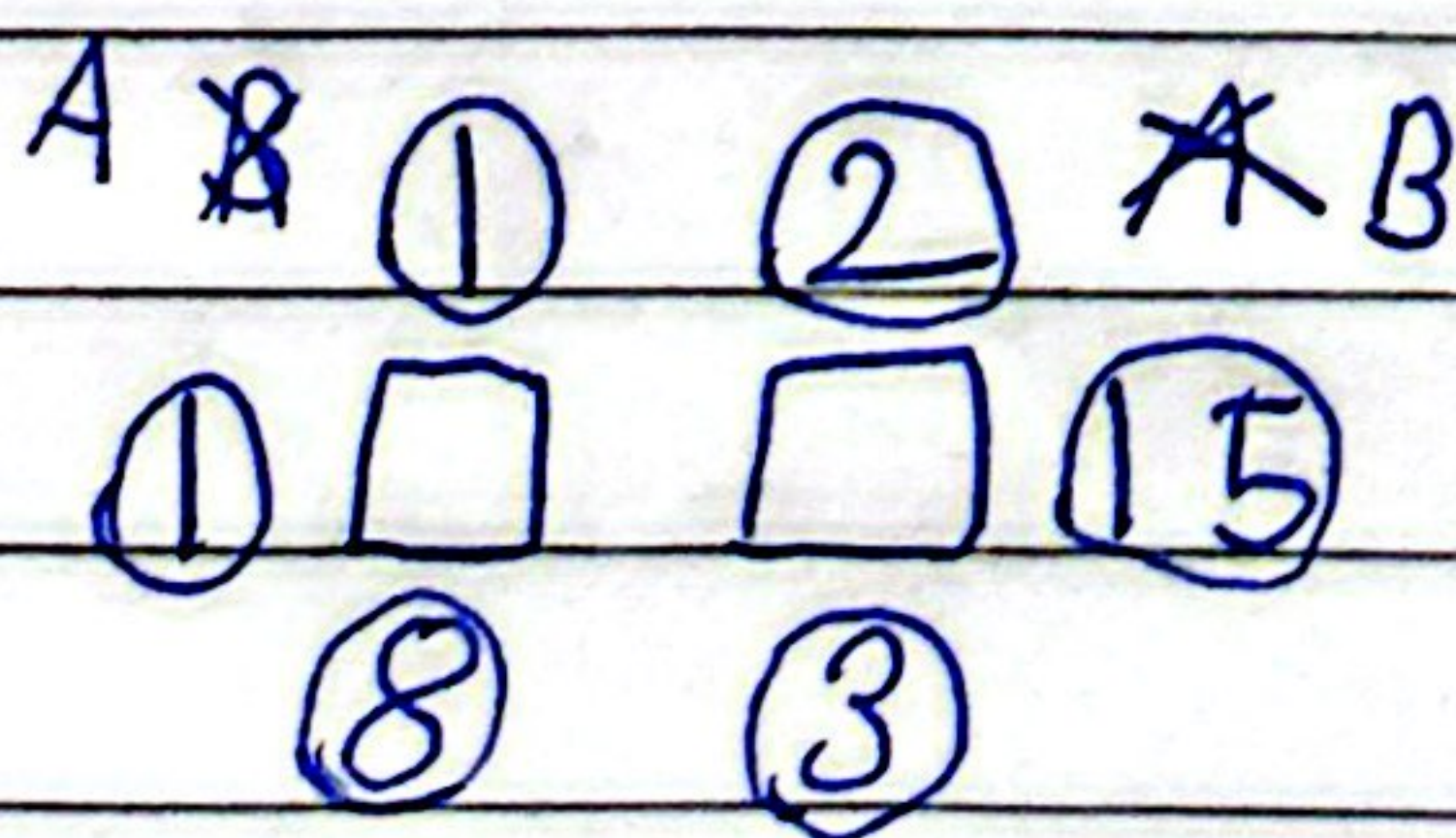
Ans: First we add 8, 9 and 3 which is 20
